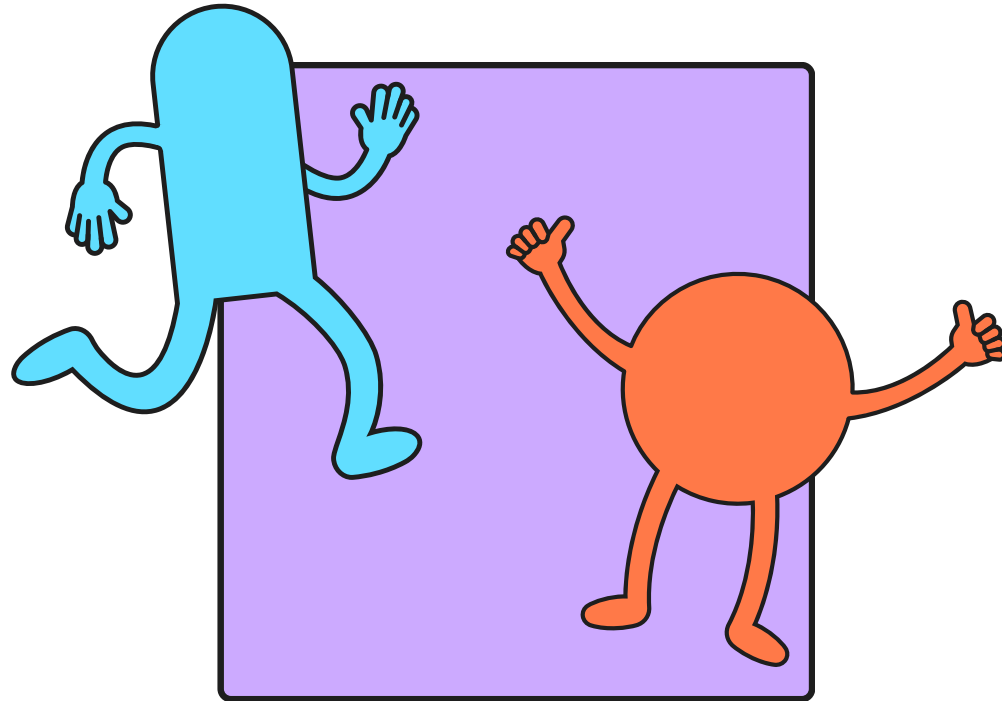
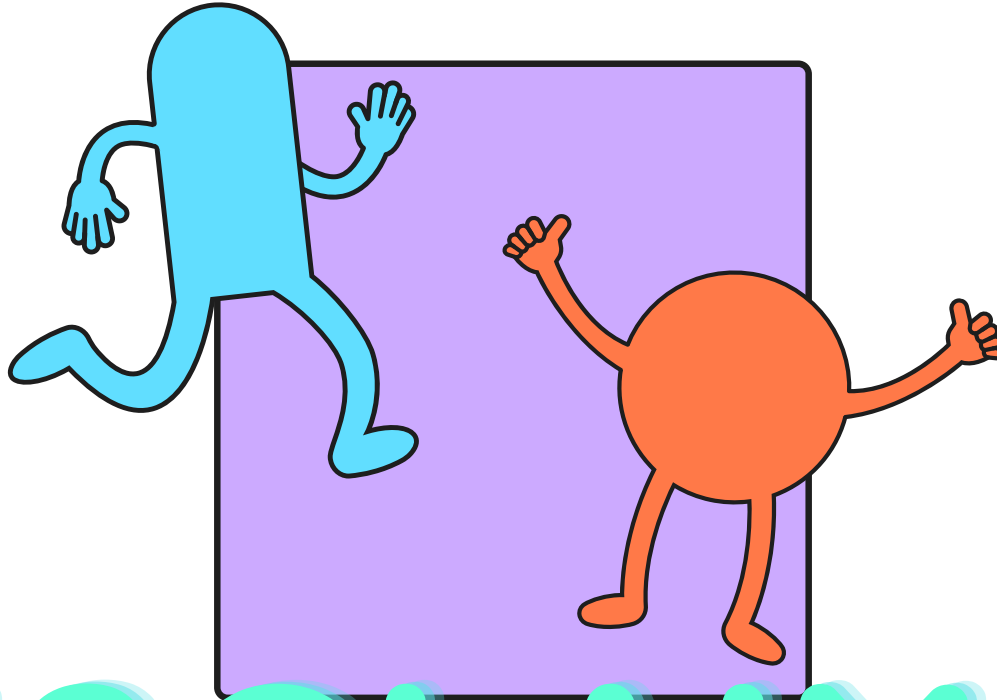

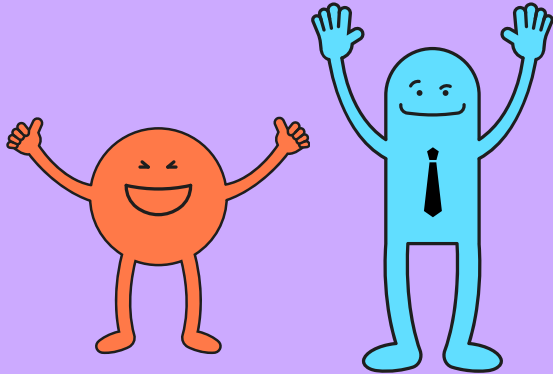

group.



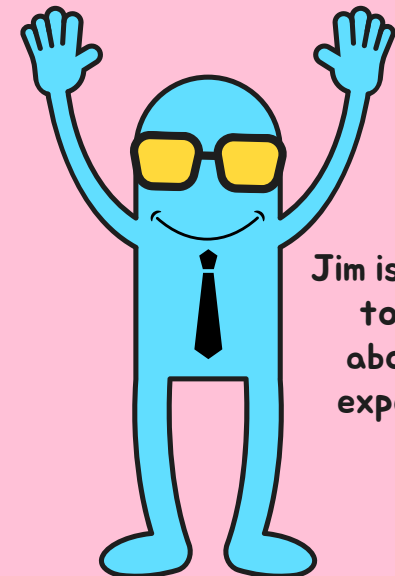
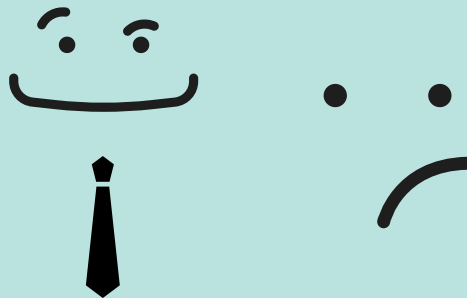

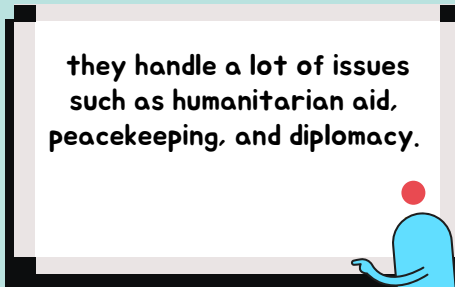

UNITED NATIONS - WHO?

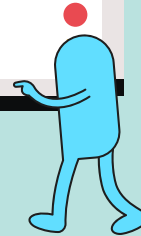
Michael & Jim head into the conference room.

they handle a lot of issues such as humanitarian aid, peacekeeping, and diplomacy.

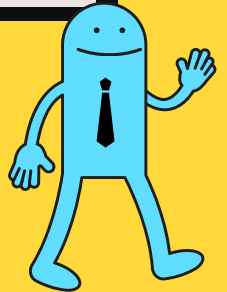

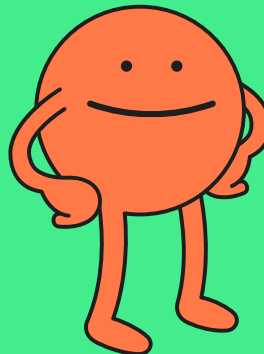

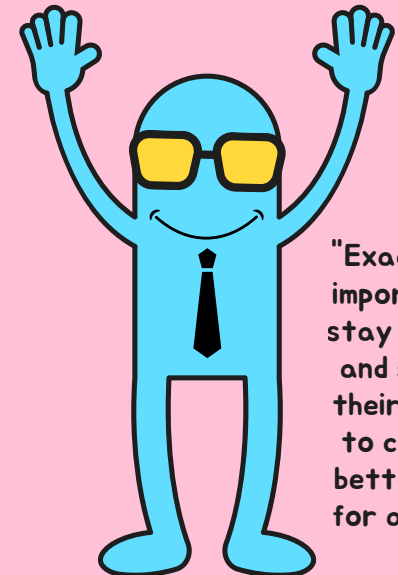


"Nope! They have a wide range of responsibilities. But they can only be effective if member states work together and support their efforts."

WHAT ARE SDGs?

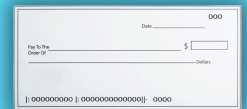
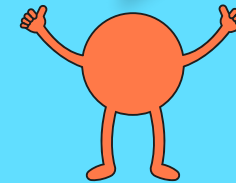
SDG 2 for example provides standards and resources to implement Zero Hunger programs.

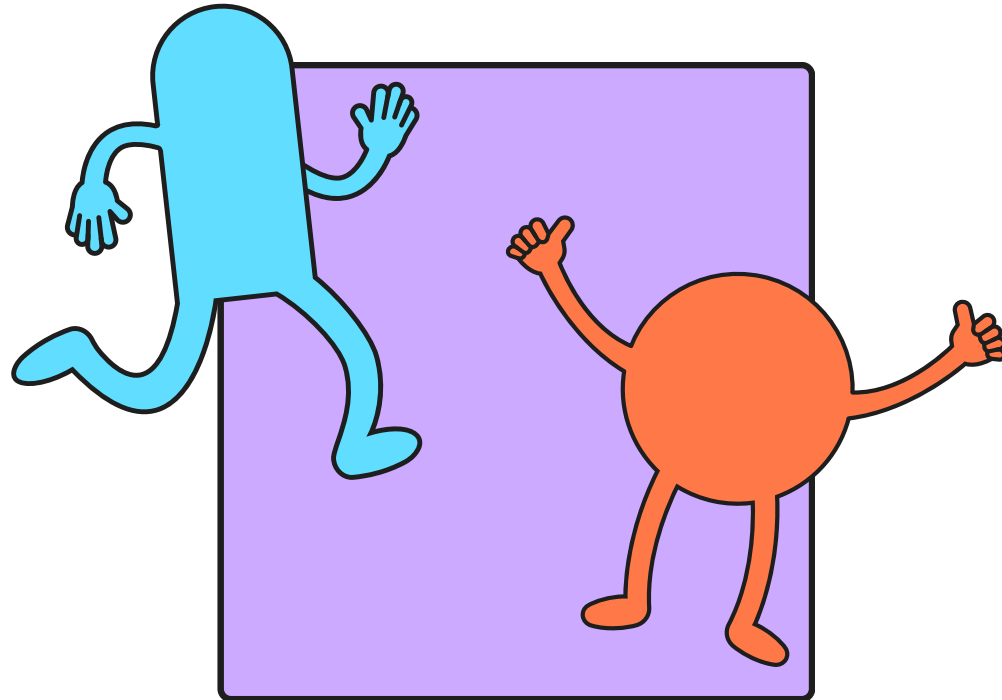
